In this 3-class series, students will learn the basic techniques of Egg Decorating including the cleaning and preparation of goose eggs, applying wax and dye to eggs using tools like pin heads, feathers, and a Kistka (limited supply in class), and then finally the big reveal after cleaning wax off the eggs, final touches, and the optional addition of a hanger or varnish.
